- 1) Click & hold the left mouse button on Row 1 and highlight down to Row 25. Right click on one of the highlighted row #s, click on **ROW HEIGHT**, and change the size to 19.
- 2) Click & hold the left mouse button on Column A and highlight across to Column W. Right click on one of the highlighted column letters, click on COLUMN WIDTH, and change the size to 3.
- 3)) Highlight Row 1, from Column A to Column W, MERGE & CENTER (Home → Alignment → Merge & Center), then type the title <u>SAT Vocabulary Crossword</u> in your merged cells.
- 4) Jump down to the Row 3 and begin creating your crossword puzzle ANSWER KEY between rows 3 to 25 AND columns A to W

Use ALL BORDERS to outline your answers (Home → Font → All Borders) ... remember 1 letter per cell

- 6) Delete the answers and place a number in the cells where a word begins. Use Font size 8 and Align the text to the top left corner of the cell (Home → Alignment → Align Left and Home → Alignment → Top Align)
- 7) Use a dictionary website to find definitions for all the words you used in your crossword puzzle
 - * Pick short and sweet definitions related to computers
- 8) Type <u>ACROSS</u> in cell D27 and <u>DOWN</u> in cell P27.

Type the definitions for each answer in the appropriate section (i.e. all the words that you typed going left to right should have their definitions below the word ACROSS)

- 9) Change SHEET2's name to HANDOUT
- *If you can use 15 terms you get EXTRA CREDIT! ☺

^{*}In a crossword puzzle, words have to be going from left to right...or top to bottom.... Words cannot be backwards!

^{*} Each word has to be connected to at least 1 other word in the puzzle.

^{*}You cannot put two words right next to each other either vertically or horizontally.
